

**Sun City Community Theatre
General Meeting
December 14, 2006**

President Carl Nusbaum called the December meeting to order. Members agreed to skip reading of the November minutes.

Treasurer Sharon Walker reported that the balance at the end of November was \$46,438.08. She pointed out that much of the money was being held in reserve for future equipment and production costs. She also urged everyone to fill out application forms when renewing memberships and said member packets will be available in January and at subsequent monthly meetings.

Anne Nusbaum reported that it may now be possible to present "My Fair Lady" at Bluffton High School June 21, 22, 23, 29 and 30 and possibly on a sixth date because rehearsal time will be available at Pinckney Hall. Auditions for the musical will be held from noon to 5 p.m. January 6 at Pinckney. Additional rehearsal time is still needed.

No names of nominees had been submitted to the club secretary by December 1; therefore, the nominees announced the previous month were elected. They are Bob Taylor, president; Sharon Walker, vice president; Carl Lehmann, treasurer; Arturo Iriarte, secretary; Ralph Spiegel, production chairman; Brenda Compton, social chairwoman; and Anne Nusbaum, member at large.

Outgoing Board members Steve Koehl, Perry Molinaro and Cindy Scott were honored for their years of service. Steve, former production chairman, and Perry, former secretary, received award of merit plaques. Cindy, former social chairwoman, had to leave the meeting early and will receive a similar plaque.

Carl noted that this was his last year as president, but will serve on the Board as past president. He thanked members for their support. The approximately 300 members present gave him a standing ovation for his service on the Board.

Bob Taylor, director, thanked the cast and crew for their work on the evening's production – "Murder's Bad But Monday Can Kill You." Bob pointed out that the cast rehearsed on stage only four times before the actual show. "Murder's Bad" will also be presented January 19-21 at the Ulmer Auditorium in Bluffton.

The hilarious two-act whodunit starred Bob McCloskey, Maya White, Lew Apgar, Bernie Anderson, Gordon Hooper, Gabrielle Testa, Joan Galasso, Carole Carl, Ed Galloway, Anne Blue and Larry Della Vecchia. Carl Lehmann was assistant director. The appreciative audience gave a standing ovation at the close of the show.

Earlier that evening, 150 members attended the dinner portion of the annual dinner and show meeting.
