## General Membership Meeting – Minutes April 4, 2007

The meeting was called to order by President Robert Taylor promptly at 7 p.m.

Bob called upon Carl Lehmann, Treasurer, to provide the membership with an update on the financial status of the organization. Carl reported that SCCT is financially sound with a current balance of \$49,695.57.

In particular he thanked Carol Wroblewski for her vision in selecting *The Boy Friend*, a play that had not been one recommended for the 2007 season. Members were informed that rehearsals for *My Fair Lady* are underway. Performance will take place at Bluffton High School in June. **MFL** is expected to be a phenomenal production with an incredible set designed by Gordon Hooper. Other on-going activities include the Actors' Workshop led by Carl Nusbaum. The individuals involved in the Actors' Workshop will entertain members at the May monthly meeting. This and other workshops offered by SCCT are opportunities for everyone to find a way of getting more actively involved in the organizations. The June performance will be directed by Perry Molinaro, July by Elba Laino and August by Esther Rosen. Bob urged all members to consider becoming more actively involved with the organization...on stage, behind stage, publicity, etc.

Bob announced that at the next monthly meeting scheduled for May 24, SCCT will host its own Club Fair to introduce members to the different areas of theatre that can open an opportunity for active involvement in the organization. The SCCT Club Fair will begin at 6:30 p.m. with light refreshments. There will be no formal meeting that evening. The monthly performance will immediately follow the Club Fair.
